AGRO FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRY IN GHANA

- ❁ The Food Processing industry in Ghana and West Africa is expected to grow by around 20% annually between 2020–2025 with domestic food processing and packaging in cocoa based and fruit based industry expected to increase production and processing capacity.
- ❁ SMEs (Small to Medium Scale enterprises) form the major chunk of food processing industry in Ghana and West Africa: 85% of employment and contribute 70% to Ghana's Gross Domestic Product (GDP). Majority of the food industries are located in Accra and Tema.
- ❁ The Food Packaging Market is expected to grow at a CAGR of 4% during the forecast period 2017–2023. Consumer packaged goods are expected to boost their market value in the coming years by CAGRs between 13% and 16%.
- ❁ Ghanaian's spend about 41% of their income on food and beverages. In 2013, total sales of packaged foods were USD 1,276 Mn.


FACTORS OF CHANGE & DEVELOPMENT

Rapid urbanization and an evolving middle class have triggered food consumption patterns and demand for convenient and quality foods/ pack food. With urban lifestyle and standard of living getting better, the demand for FMCG and processed food through formal markets and super markets, is increasing exponentially.

With government attention for expanding the food processing capacity and growth of domestic sector for self-sufficiency, food security, employment creation and exports, the private players and MNCs are also focusing tapping the market, particularly in the resource based food processing sector.

THE PRIDE OF AFRICA



Ghana, officially known as the Republic of Ghana – the country in West Africa, bordered by Burkina Faso to the North, Togo to the East, Cote d'Ivoire to the West and the Gulf of Guinea (Ocean) to the South.

Land area dedicated for agriculture, however less than 2% is irrigated

Cocoa is the dominant agriculture sector, followed by cash crops like palm oil seeds, fruits and marginal crops like coconut, rubber, cashew etc.

GHANA & WEST AFRICA AGRI BUSINESS MARKET

Ghana is becoming the centre of Business and Agriculture transformation in the West Africa region emerging as a trading manufacturing, logistics hub with better and conducive trade policies & duty structure.

Government schemes like Planting for Food & Jobs and Planning for Exports co-located with 1 District 1 Factory scheme expected to attain agriculture & food processing self sufficiency and exports.

Agriculture Technology, undoubtedly the biggest demand and requirement in Ghana and West African region after pharmaceuticals, is identified as key area to be worked for employment and development.

Targeted double digit growth in crop production like maize (30%); rice (49%); soybean (25%); and sorghum (28%) from current levels & create 75,000 new jobs, directly & indirectly.

Ghana, with bilateral trade ties & agreements with its neighbours in West Africa and line of credits between Ghana and India & other countries, it is opportunistic to encash by supplying agriculture technology and requirements.

Ghanaian Agritech & Machineries importation towards USD 1.29 Bn in 2023. Major share occupied by India, China, Belgium, USA, Brazil, Russia, United Kingdom and Turkey.

The government has announced plans to revamp Metro Mass Transit Limited (MMTL) and Intensity STC Coaches Limited as part of efforts to improve safety and efficiency in public transport.

Speaking during the government Accountability series on Wednesday, September 17, Transport Minister Joseph Niike acknowledged the financial challenges facing the sector and assured that steps are being taken to modernise the fleet, including the production of electronic buses.

According to him, the government will procure a new fleet comprising 250 Toyota Hiace buses, 100 Toyota buses, and 50 trucks, to be delivered in phases by the end of 2025.

"The government is committed to revitalising Metro Mass Transit Limited and Intensity STC Coaches Limited, which are currently in distress and need urgent financial support. We planned to modernise their fleet and upgrade existing infrastructure for efficient service delivery."

"MMTL fleet will include 350 Toyota Hiace buses, 100 Toyota buses, and 50 cargo trucks. Delivery will commence at the end of this year through early 2026."

"Other arrangements are underway to modernise Intensity STC Buses in phases, including the introduction of electronic buses for their operations," he said.
